SAIT Polytechnic is beginning a multi-year program redesign and development for the Rehabilitation Therapy Assistant (RHT) program to reflect upcoming accreditation requirements and program changes. As a result, SAIT requires a subject matter expert or subject matter experts (SMEs) in rehabilitation therapy (both physical and occupational) on a contract basis to review and revise existing curriculum.

Contracts are available for work on nine on-line and face-to-face courses in subject areas such as Anatomy of Movement, Patient Care, Life Span Development, Interpersonal Skills and Therapeutic Relationships, Foundations of Occupational Therapy and Health Conditions. Approximately 140 hours of work will be involved for each course and the work must be completed between September 2010 and June 30, 2011. Additional contracts for course development may be available for the 2011-2012 academic year. Applicants may choose to apply for one, several or all nine of the course contracts.

The Subject Matter Expert(s) will report to the Academic Chair responsible for the RHT program. They will also be expected to work with the curriculum development team which includes the Curriculum Coordinator for the School of Health and Public Safety, the project manager, instructional designer and multimedia developer.

RESPONSIBILITIES

As a member of the curriculum development team, the SME will:

- Align course outcomes to program outcomes
- Develop a course schedule
- Develop a learning plan
- Review and revise existing course outline, assignments and assessments.
- Create new lessons, presentations, activities, assignments and assessments.

QUALIFICATIONS

The successful applicant or applicants will have a relevant qualification as a physiotherapist, occupational therapist or therapy assistant with at least 5 years of recent clinical experience and experience in post-secondary instruction or curriculum development. Experience with online instruction and educational qualifications. A demonstrated ability to work independently in document production and to meet project timelines will be required.
