The Speech Language Pathologist Assistant is responsible for providing support to the Speech Language Pathologists in the implementation of the children's programs. They must demonstrate the ability to work closely with the therapists and teachers in creating a therapeutic, stimulating and nurturing environment. They must possess good organizational skills and the ability to work independently as well as function as part of a multi-disciplinary team.

Duties:

- Implement therapist's goals.
- Documentation and record keeping of daily activities with each child.
- Work as part of multidisciplinary team.
- Responsible for materials necessary for therapy implementation.

Education:

Diploma in Speech Language Pathologist Assistant preferable. A degree or diploma in human/child services or health care related field would be considered. Class IV driver's license is required before start date upon hire.
